Athens: Glyfada Golf Club

18-holes, open all year round, built in 1962

Halkidiki (Northern Greece): inside Porto Carras Resort, 18 holes, open all year round

Corfu island: Corfu Golf & Country Club

18 holes, open Apr-Oct, built 1972

Rhodes island: Afandou Golf Course

18-holes course, open all year round, built in 1973

Crete island: 2 golf courses

Inside Porto Elounda Hotel: 9 holes, open all year round

Crete Golf Club: 18 holes, open all year round, built in 2003
